Bequest Grant Fund balances as of 31 January 2002 stood at \$10,054.05 for the Saltups Fund and \$3,921.33 for the Grundmanis Fund. This represents income earned by the Endowment that is currently available for distribution.

All fund balances (including certain AABS operating reserves) are managed by the AABS Investment Committee, chaired by Juris Padegs, (Advisory Managing Director, Scudder Kemper Investments, Inc., New York), with members Gundar J. King (Dean Emeritus, School of Business, Pacific Lutheran University), Juris Vīksniņš (Professor of Economics, Georgetown University, Washington, D.C.), and Tiit Heinsoo (Managing Director, Montgomery Watson-Asia [Retired]). Currently, the Investment Committee has placed all funds in a series of portfolios managed by the Frank Russell Investment Management Co. of Tacoma, WA. Total
