





Funchal, Madeira's largest port, is an idyllic wonderland with colorful flowers, ornate architecture and panoramic mountain f. A wander through the local shops reveals a host of embroidery, vibrant tapestries and detailed wickerwork.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13 SANTA CRUZ DE LA PALMA, CANARY ISLANDS

Santa Cruz de la Palma hugs the east coast of the island of La Palma. The old town showcases a Caribbean feel with its distinctly balconied buildings painted in hues of blue, green, orange and burgundy. Cobbled streets lead to an equally colorful marketplace bursting with mangoes, passion fruit and sugar cane.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 14 SANTA CRUZ DE TENERIFE

Tenerife lies northwest of the African continent and is the largest and most populated island of the Canary Archipelago. The island's original economy was based on agriculture, including the harvesting of bananas and potatoes. Today, new industrial products and activities, such as oil and paper mills, have slowly emerged. Nonetheless, tourism remains the island's main industry, and islanders are eager to greet you with enthusiasm and warmth.
