## Faculty Meeting Minutes (Non-executive session) May 2, 2017

- Meeting called to order by chair at 12:05pm.
- Prior meeting minutes were approved.
- Karen Beaudry was welcomed as the new CFRM Career Services Manager. Karen's background brings significant experience ranging from IT to career counseling and more.
- Bernard reminded faculty of the following:
