David S. Jardine, M.D., is an associate professor of Anesthesiology and Pediatrics. He is an attending physician, practicing pediatric anesthesiology and pediatric critical care at Children's Hospital and pediatric critical care at Harborview Hospital. He joined the staff of Children's Hospital in 1987 after completing residencies in pediatrics, anesthesiology, and a fellowship in pediatric anesthesiology and intensive care. He has published numerous chapters and peer-reviewed articles, with an emphasis on hemorrhagic shock and encephalopathy syndrome, which is a special interest of his. His laboratory based research interests are in using heat induced gene expression and heat shock proteins as biomarkers for heat induced injury in sudden infant death syndrome. He has been the principal investigator on a number of grants and is the recipient of ongoing NIH funding. He has served as a reviewer for a variety of medical journals. He serves on the Institutional Review Board at Children's Hospital and on the research committee for the Department of Anesthesiology. He acts as an ad hoc reviewer for research funding proposals for Children's Hospital and for the Department of Anesthesiology. He has served on the board of NISSA (Northwest Infant Survival and SIDS Alliance) for a number of years, including three years as president.
