### Notes:

Work in Progress: Presentations may focus on 1) new project / grant ideas, or 2) practicing oral presentations for conferences and seminars.

Journal Club: We will solicit presenters for Journal club and will also have some specific topics identified in advance for sessions.

Grantsmanship: Background readings will be sent out in advance of these meetings and several sessions will include review opportunities (e.g., Specific Aims) for proposals in preparation.
