## APPLICATION PROCESS

All positions for the program will be filled through the NRMP match process starting for entry in June 2012. This will be a separate match. Applicants are also welcome to apply for the regular categorical and/or advanced anesthesia program at the same time. Candidates will be ranked according to their abilities, interest and aptitude for ICU training.

Candidates should be aware that this is a 5 year program and once candidates have matched into the program early release from training will require an application for a waiver from the NMRP. See NMRP website for full details on waivers and releases from NMRP participating programs.
