Required Funds for Entering International Students Approximately \$56,151 (Academic year 2009-2010)
International students must prove their ability to cover these costs before the application for a visa can be issued

Tuition, books, living expenses (non-resident 3 quarters) Approximately \$42,408 (academic year 2009-2010)
Please note that 2010-2011 tuition fees will not be available until July 2010.

Tuition, books, living expenses (resident 3 quarters) Approximately \$29,048 (academic year 2009-2010)
Please note that 2010-2011 tuition fees will not be available until July 2010.
