**Applications are invited for Assistant, Associate or Full-Professor in the area of integrated structural technologies and design.**

The Department of Architecture, together with the University of Washington administration and the Dean of the College of Architecture and Urban Planning, recognize the critical importance of interdisciplinary collaborative teaching and faculty creative achievement. The Department of Architecture works closely with the Department of Construction Management to stress an integrated design environment that synthesizes engineering, sustainability and digital simulation technology within the classroom and studio environment, research and practice.

The position includes instructional duties in the Department of Architecture's B.A. & M. Arch. programs and potentially in the Masters of Science in Architecture and the College's Ph.D. in the Built Environment. The successful candidate will teach introductory classes in structural design and analysis for buildings, is expected to develop new courses in his/her primary area of interest, and assist in the integration of structural technologies into the culture of design studio. Applicants must have advanced knowledge in some aspect of structural engineering and be able to supervise advanced graduate research studies, and have the potential to develop innovative funded research or professional practice. Applicants must hold a minimum of a professional degree in architecture or engineering, and show promise of excellence in teaching, research and/or practice. The level of appointment and salary will be commensurate with the successful applicant's experience.

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

This appointment is for nine-months at 50% - 100% and scheduled to commence in the next academic year, 2008-2009. Applications must be in an 8.5 x 11 inch or A4 format, and include the following:
