General Requirements: Fluency in Modern Standard Chinese (determined by oral interview), minimum GPA of 3.0 in all required courses

- II. Classical Chinese (5 credits):

- III. General knowledge about the Chinese language (10 credits):  
CHIN 342 or 442 The Chinese Language  
CHIN 443 Structure of Chinese
- IV. General knowledge about Chinese literature (20 credits):  
CHIN 461-462-463 History of Chinese Literature  
Any one of the following:  
ASIAN 201 Literature and Culture of Ancient and Classical China  
ASIAN 204 Literature and Culture of China from Tradition to  
Modernity  
CHIN 373 Chinese Poetry  
CHIN 374 Chinese Prose  
CHIN 380 The Chinese Novel in English
- VI. Chinese history (5 credits):  
HSTAS 211 History of Chinese Civilization  
(or an approved alternative)

TOTAL CREDIT REQUIREMENT = 55 credits, 50 credits from the Department of Asian Languages and Literature and 5 from the Department of History
