
Overall Map 总示意图





WHAT IS A BIOSWALE?



A bioswale is a natural way of using plants to remove pollution from runoff water.



Runoff from urban areas is a common source of water pollution. It can carry harmful pollutants such as herbicides, fertilizers, oil, and household chemicals that can be harmful to fish and wildlife.

Bioswales are a natural way of removing pollutants and prevent flooding runoff because it mimics natural streams.

A bioswale is a depression built with a dense cover of different vegetation. Runoff is directed through this bioswale during storm events. The water then flows to the watered plants and soil to settle to the bottom. The pollutants are then absorbed into the soil where they may be incorporated.

The vegetation within the bioswale provides water treatment by absorbing each pollutant and sending it to the water. The vegetation within the bioswale also provides food and shelter for wildlife. This bioswale is designed to help sediment reduction, flooding prevention, habitat for water wildlife such as non-native frogs, waterfowl families, and migratory birds.

Some of the water that enters the bioswale filters into the groundwater. The rest of the water flows into Jasper Slough which connects to the Mill Race. The water in the Mill Race flows into the Willamette River and eventually out to the Pacific Ocean.


