

W. Lance Bennett is Professor of Political Science and Ruddick C. Lawrence Professor of Communication at the University of Washington, where he also directs the Center for Communication and Civic Engagement (www.engagedcitizen.org). The general focus of his work is how communication processes affect citizen engagement with politics. Publications include: *Mediated Politics: Communication in the Future of Democracy* (Cambridge University Press, 2001, co-edited with Robert Entman); *News: The Politics of Illusion*, 7th ed. (Longman, 2007); and *When the Press Fails: Political Power and the News Media from Iraq to Katrina* (University of Chicago Press, 2007, co-authored with Regina Lawrence and Steven Livingston). He has received the Ithiel de Sola Pool Award and Lectureship, and the Murray Edelman Career Achievement Award in Political Communication, both from the American Political Science Association.
