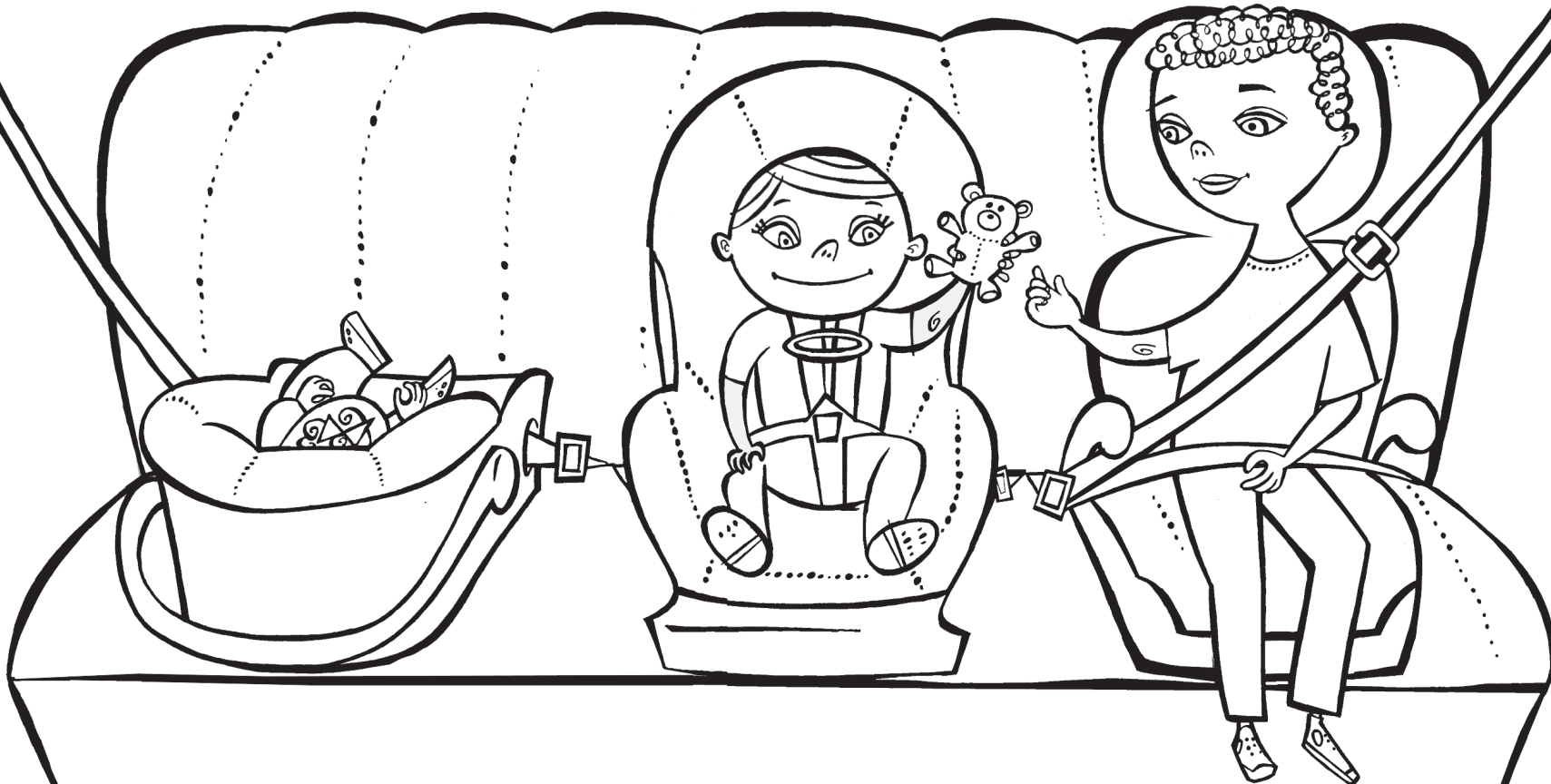


Buckle up. It's the law.

1-4 years

20-40 pounds

Booster seat
4-8 years

up to 4 feet, 9 inches tall

Car and booster seats are required by law in Washington State for children up to age 6 or 60 pounds.

Beginning in 2007, the law will require children to ride in a booster seat up to age 8 or until they are 4 feet, 9 inches tall.

Seat belts are required by law for everyone in the car.
