The Ontario HIV Treatment Network (OHTN) will be providing a grant to cover the costs of registration, airfare and/or accommodation for conference participants who are working to address HIV in the context of the social determinants of health such as those working in areas such as housing, mental health, addictions, activity limitations and employment and poverty, health services and access to care for vulnerable and hard to reach populations. The purpose of this funding is to support and encourage the development of community-based research (CBR) knowledge, capacity and partnerships within the HIV sector in Ontario. Only participants who are residents of Ontario are eligible to apply.

This scholarship is specifically designed for community-based individuals who require financial support in order to participate at the conference (i.e., applicants who are not employed at a higher educational institution or a government-based agency). Those actively engaged in CBR partnerships and those seeking to become engaged, are also eligible to apply, however priority will be given to community members living with HIV/AIDS, conference presenters and individuals from community-based organizations. We are also committed to supporting a diverse group of applicants including people working in various geographic locations, and with diverse client groups (e.g., gender, race and ethnicity, sexual orientation), and students without funding support to attend conferences.

Applicants will be notified of a decision on their applications in January 2007. Those approved for funding will receive instructions for how to register for the conference, make air travel arrangements and/or hotel reservations.
