

Instructions for Graduate Nonmatriculated Students applying to the Graduate Certificate Program in HIV and STI's:

Graduate nonmatriculated students (GNM) students must be affiliated with a degree program even though they are not completing a master's degree. (However, credits taken in GNM status *may* be counted toward future degree program requirements). GNM students applying to the HIV-STI certificate program will be affiliated with the **Epidemiology Department (EPI)** and IN ADDITION to completing the graduate certificate program application must also send an application to the EPI department and to the graduate school. The application will not be considered complete until all of these steps have been completed.

APPLICATION

1) Fill out the Graduate Certificate Program application as described in the program website. http://depts.washington.edu/cfas/training/grad_cert/

2) For the Graduate School and Epidemiology Department application, please go to: <https://www.grad.washington.edu/applForAdmiss/> and fill out an applicant profile and upload a statement of purpose and a resume CV. For your statement of purpose you should use the “goal statement” written for the HIV-STI certificate program.

GNM applicants must select “GNM” in the application system and then have to select a degree track even though they won't be admitted to a degree program. Students should select the “Epidemiology MPH General Track” for coding purposes only.

We require a TOEFL for international applicants who do not hold a US bachelor's or higher. The details are explained in the application website.

Note: Faculty/staff tuition exempt students register through the MyUW system, but cannot register until the 3rd day of the quarter.
