

## **Department Resources - Instructional & Laboratory Services - Instructional: Chemistry Library**

**CHEMISTRY LIBRARY**, a branch of the University of Washington Libraries, emphasizes the areas of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering. It also includes materials from such interdisciplinary areas as surface science, biotechnology, and polymer applications. The collection currently holds approximately 60,000 volumes with additional material in storage.

Pharmacy, pharmacology, biochemistry, and protein chemistry are collected by the Health Sciences Library. Additional related material may be found in other units of the University of Washington Libraries.

The Chemistry Library is located in CHL 60, on the lower level of the Chemistry Library Building. Faculty and graduate students from Chemistry and Chemical Engineering may be issued keys for after-hour access. Please do not let any unauthorized users into the Library. Regularly circulated materials may be checked out after hours—instructions and due dates are found at the circulation desk. Reference materials and periodicals marked "Library Use Only" do not circulate. Abuse of after-hours privileges may result in the loss of those privileges.

The Chemistry Library provides reference assistance, on-line searching, bibliographic instruction, etc.

Coin-operated and card-operated, photocopy machines are available in the Library (CHL 60B).
