
BITZER'S ADDITION

DESCRIPTION

and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the S.W. Corner of said Sec. 18, thence N. 89°23'19"E.,

550'along the South Line of said Sec. 18 to the True Point of


Beginning; thence continue N. 89°23'19"E., 289.26' along said Sec.

Line; thence N. 0°36'41"W., 124.80' to an intersection with the Westerly Boundary of "C" St. S.E., thence N. 27°06'11"W., 151.02' along said Boundary to an intersection with the South Line of the alley of Young's First Add'n, to Auburn extended East; thence 5.89°23'19" W,385.50' along said South Line to the Westerly Boundary of B' St. S.E., thence S.O°21'31" W., 44.95', along said Boundary to the Easterly Boundary of Young's First Add'n.; thence 5.38°00'26"E., 157.37' along said Easterly Boundary to the South Boundary of 7th. St. S.E., thence N.89°23'19"E., 68.79; along said South Boundary of 7th. St. S.E., thence S.O°36'41"E., 89.99' to the True Point of Beginning.

DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the Western Washington Corp. of Seventh Day Adventists, owners in fee simple of the land hereby platted, hereby declare this plat and dedicate to the use of the public forever all streets shown hereon with the following restrictions: All restrictions, rules, and regulations of the City of Auburn Planning Commission and Zoning and Building Ordinances. No unsightly outbuildings shall be permitted and the exteriors of all buildings shall be completed and painted within six months from the date such buildings are started. No parcel of this property shall be sold, rented, or leased to, or occupied by any person not a member of the Caucasian or white race, except servants domesticated with an owner or tenant.
