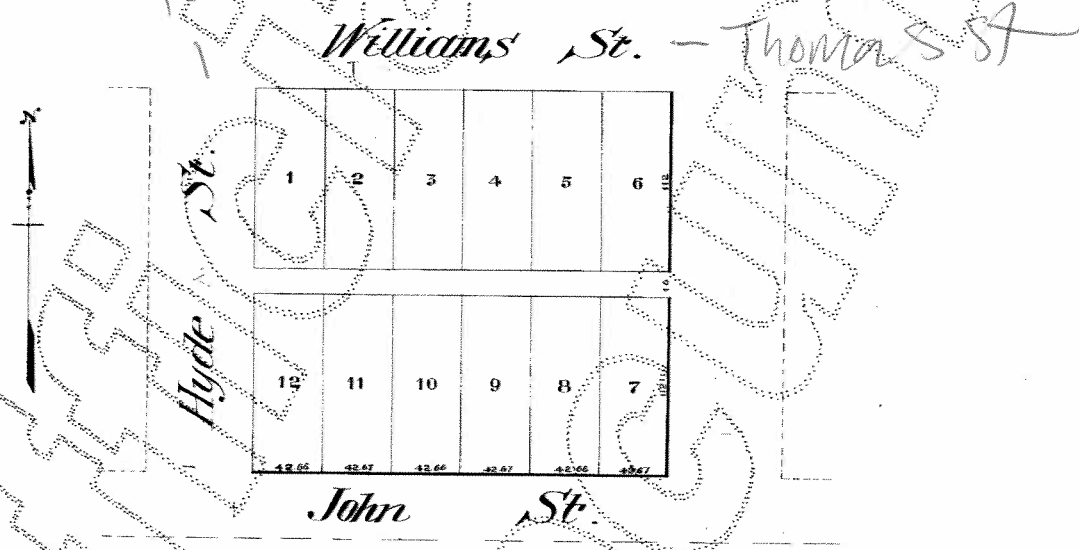


Supplemental Plat To GLEN PARK ADDITION To the City of Seattle W.T.

Description.

The land embraced in this Supplemental Plat to Glen Park Addition in the City of Seattle, is described as follows: - Commencing at a point which is 966 feet North and 104 feet East of the S.W. corner of Section 28, T.P. 25, N. 22, W. 21. Thence South 244 feet, thence East 266 feet, thence North 240 feet, thence West 266 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 1 1/2 acre, more or less, and popularly known as Block S.D.M. Grant's Addition (replatted) as shown by McWhincher & Thompson's Map of 1887. All dimensions are as shown. The Initial Point is the point of commencement which is the N.W. cor. of the Block.
