The Shasta-Trinity National Forest is seeking a dynamic, innovative self starter for the National Recreation area. The duty location is Mountain Gate, California. This position is located on a Ranger District and meets the definition of a Forest Service Fire Management Program (FS-FPM) position as designated by WO Fire Management.

Duties:

- Manage a large, complex fuels program including hazardous fuels.
- Provide supervision for fuels program personnel.
- Participate in non-governmental groups such as fire safe councils
- Provide district fuels budget and program planning input for short and long-range fuels projects, coordinate and supervise efforts of other fuel program employees. Manage grants and agreements.
- Participate on Interdisciplinary Teams, providing input to the environmental compliance process. May perform as team leader on projects, act as Interdisciplinary Team specialist, and/or act as point of contact for Enterprise Team coordination.
- Primary contact with other resource areas covering Shasta Lake Ranger Unit as well as adjoining management units and cooperators to accomplish fuels projects.

- Perform as primary Contracting Officer's Representative on a variety of fuels reduction contracts. Manage projects and environmental compliance monitoring program.
- Organize and manage the planning and implementation of all prescribed burning.
- Provide fire suppression and prescribed fire assistance based on certified incident qualifications.

Forest:

The Shasta-Trinity National Forest, located in north central California, is the largest national forest in California and provides some of the highest quality fish and wildlife habitat in the Pacific Northwest. It is comprised of 2.1 million acres in the Klamath and South Cascade Mountains ranging in elevation from 1,000 feet to 14,162 at the summit of Mt. Shasta. This forest encompasses five wilderness areas, hundreds of mountain lakes and more than 6,000 miles of streams and rivers. In addition, there are wild and scenic rivers, national trails and scenic byways and a National Recreation Area. For further information on the forest, please go to www.fs.usda.gov/stnf

Community

This position is located at the Shasta Lake Ranger Station along Interstate 5 about 10 miles north of Redding in northern California. The Ranger Station manages the Shasta and Trinity Lake units of the Whiskeytown-Shasta-Trinity National Recreation Area (NRA), which was established by Congress in 1965. Shasta Lake, with approximately 30,000 surface acres is the largest human-made reservoir in California. Trinity Lake, with approximately 17,000 surface acres, is also a large reservoir. Both are popular recreation destinations. Many opportunities await the recreation enthusiast such as fishing, sailing, water-skiing, swimming, camping, hiking, mountain biking, and much more.

Redding is a full service community of 90,000 people. Redding is also located along Interstate 5 and has a fine variety of medical facilities, schools including Shasta College, Simpson College, restaurants, retail stores, museums and housing opportunities. Cultural and outdoor recreational activities include music, art, fishing, rafting, skiing, hiking, sailing, swimming and more. The Redding area has a Mediterranean climate with mild winters and dry, hot summers. Housing is readily available with an average 3-bedroom house selling for about \$200,000; residential dwellings in either urban or rural settings can be found within a reasonable commute distance to the NRA office. Rent for 2-bedroom apartment ranges from \$600 to \$1,000 a month, 3-bedroom house ranges from \$800 to \$1,450 a month. Government housing is not available.
