Amy Henry and I are PhD students at U. Chicago advised by Dr. Cathy Pfister and Dr. Tim Wootton. Our summer research is based out of FHL, and we are looking for two individuals to assist with the field components of our projects around the San Juan Islands in summer 2014.

One assistant will join me for fieldwork at rocky intertidal sites on San Juan Island, and the other will work primarily in soft sediment seagrass sites on Orcas Island with Amy. Because our work is entirely intertidal, scheduling will be inconsistent with a traditional 5-day week (lots of work during good low tides, much less work between tide series).
