Position Details

As a **Resource Supervisor**, you will be managing the forestry operations for the Fordyce District, which is a part of the Crossett Unit; the district encompasses approximately 236,000 acres with an annual harvest of 1.2 million tons. Key areas of responsibility include harvesting and managing wood flow to meet customer commitments, negotiating contracts for timber sales and logging services, land management and silviculture, monitoring environmental and Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) compliance. You will lead a team of 4 Foresters and 5 Technicians.

As a **Resource Supervisor**, you will have the opportunity to:

- Coach and develop a team of professional foresters
- Collaborate with the Resource and Marketing Managers on marketing efforts for this district
- Manage/administer contracts and contractors (logging, hauling, road building/maintenance)
- Ensure sufficient contractor capacity to meet Plum Creek's marketing commitments
- Manage annual revenues of \$36 million, adjust forecasts to meet changing business needs, forecast harvest volumes, log and haul rates, and other expenditures

 Work closely with internal and external resources including the Land Asset Management (LAM) team identifying AVO properties and assisting in the implementation of the LAM plans
