Summary of Job Duties: Under the supervision of the Game Warden Supervisor and the general supervision of the District Chief of Enforcement, is responsible for enforcing the wildlife laws of the State of Oklahoma. Is responsible for public relations work with sportsmen, landowners, youth groups and license dealers in assigned area. May be required to assist other Divisions of the Department in carrying out programs such as game and fish surveys, creel and bag census, public relations, information and education regarding Department programs and projects. Patrols designated area by vehicle, boat, airplane or foot, checking licenses, bag limits and wildlife law violations.

## Must have the ability to:

- O Walk along creeks, lake banks, through brush or over rip rap.
- o Drive over rough back roads for extensive periods.
- o Hauling stringers or net loads of fish into boat or onto shore.
- Lift/carry and/or pull deer or other carcasses of animals into and out of pickup or through the woods to a
  vehicle
- o Drive 2/4 wheel vehicles, including ATVs.
- Operate a boat, carry an outboard motor,
- o Jog/walk over rough terrain.
- o Swim.
- o Physically control and arrest law violators.
- o Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- o Establish and maintain effective working relationships with others.

## Requirements:

**Education:** Requires a Bachelor's Degree with at least 16 credit hours of course work in wildlife related field(s). Preference is given for a degree in a wildlife related field.

**Experience:** No previous related experience with one year orientation on the job.

**Physical Ability Standards:** Must be able to meet physical ability standards.
