Position: Seasonal Forestry Technician

Overview: Lomakatsi Restoration Project (www.lomakatsi.org) is looking for seasonal Forestry Technicians to assist with field-based forestry work from mid-June to late September, 2015. The selected candidates will be responsible for collecting forest inventory data and assisting with tree marking and project unit boundary layout for ecologically-based commercial thinning projects. Students in Forestry, Forest Sciences and Natural Resources are encouraged to apply. The position is based out of Ashland, Oregon with projects spanning a three hour radius and some overnight travel required.

SALARY: \$12.50 - 16.50 / hour depending on experience
