Sir Richard Feachem is Professor of Global Health at both the University of California, San Francisco and the University of California, Berkeley and Director of the new Global Health Group at UCSE. He is also a Visiting Professor at London University and an Honorary Professor at the University of Queensland. From 2002 to 2007, Sir Richard served as founding Executive Director of the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria. During this time, the Global Fund became the world's largest health financing institution for developing countries, with assets of over US \$10.5 billion, supporting 450 programmes in 136 countries. He has worked in international health and development for 35 years and has published extensively on public health and health policy. Sir Richard was knighted by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II in 2007.
