

Accessing the UWMC Surgery Whiteboard from your own computer

In order to access the UWMC Surgery Whiteboard from any computer outside of the UWMC campus, you must log into the system using an SSL/VPN. These instructions are the same whether you use a PC, Mac, or iPad. Please be patient, sometimes the connection takes a full minute.

1. Open up any web browser (Internet Explorer, Safari, Firefox, Chrome, etc.)
2. Go to: <https://sslvpn.medical.washington.edu> and log in using your AMC account. The page should look like the image below.

3. Next we will add a permanent bookmark to the whiteboard to make access easier in the future. In the area labeled 'Web Bookmarks', click on the plus sign in the upper right hand corner.

- Under bookmark name, enter 'UWMC Surgery Whiteboard'. Under URL, enter:

<https://hmc-wb.medical.washington.edu>

Check the 'Display as favorite' checkbox near the bottom in order to make future access easier, and press 'Add Bookmark' to finish creating the shortcut.
