



CLIR: Hidden Collections Program

- Council on Library and Information Resources (CLIR)
- Cataloguing Hidden Special Collections and Archives (2008–2014)
- In 2015, the Hidden Collections launched Digitizing Hidden Special Collections and Archives: Enabling New Scholarship through Increasing Access of Unique Materials

Project Overview

- Recipient of a 2013 CLIR grant: "Discovering Modern China" is an international collaboration between UW and UBC Libraries to reveal the hidden treasures of Chinese language materials, including rare books, special collections, archival materials, etc. printed from the 14th to the early 20th century.
- Project goal is to create 2,000 original records of rare and special materials to make them discoverable on OCLC WorldCat.
- Launched in June 2014, when UW & UBC matching funds hired students to identify titles for original cataloging






Optimize the Result of the Project: Satellite Projects


