George Demiris is the Alumni Endowed Professor in Nursing at the School of Nursing and Professor of Biomedical and Health Informatics, at the School of Medicine, University of Washington. His research interests include the design and evaluation of home based technologies for older adults and patients with chronic conditions and disabilities, smart homes and ambient assisted living applications and the use of telehealth in home care and hospice.
