### Application Deadline:

Data form must be completed by midnight Pacific Time on Wednesday, February 15, 2012 and supporting application documents must be postmarked by Wednesday, February 15, 2012.

### Application Notes:

- Please arrange for personal statement, transcripts, letter of recommendation, and any supporting documents to be sent in **one package**. Please refrain from stapling documents together.
- For your personal statement, please describe your interest in the summer program. Address your motivation to engage in environmental and occupational health science research and include pertinent information regarding previous experience. List possible faculty mentors or interest areas and explain your choice. You may explore past mentors and projects on the EHREP [Student Research](#) page as well as review our [faculty directory](#). Feel free to include any personal information that will help us understand strengths or weaknesses in your application. Suggested length: 500 words. Please include your first and last name in the header of your document.
- The recommendation letter may arrive via email as long as the letter is sent directly from the recommender's college/university email account.
- Degree audits or summaries are not acceptable in place of a transcript.
