- Chairman Senior Minister at Prime Minister's Office / Crown Prince of Brunei Darussalam
- Membership Ministers in His Majesty's Government of Brunei Darussalam
- Secretariat mainly from Ministry of Health
- National Pandemic Influenza Preparedness Plan
- Other pandemic influenza preparedness at different levels:
  - Ministry
  - District
- Private sector involvement?

# PUBLIC-PRIVATE SECTOR COLLABORATION IN PANDEMIC PREPAREDNESS IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

- Exercise Phoenix
  - Joint simulation exercise involving Brunei Shell Petroleum and Ministry of Health
  - Transportation of sick workers with from an offshore platform to PMMHAMB Hospital
  - November 2006
- Study comparing pandemic influenza preparedness in government and private primary healthcare providers in the Brunei-Muara District.
