- April 6-10 Complete final phase of research projects (complete laboratory work, experiments, etc.) Start to analyze results and begin preparing your presentations
- April 13-17 **Multiple Meetings:** Practice presentations (preliminary round) [develop a 13-15 minute presentation (transparencies/PowerPoint) that includes the following components: the focus of your research; the major question (s) you explore; the theoretical background; your methodology; your preliminary results (graphs/charts); your conclusions]  
EIP staff will provide critical feedback on content, style, and pace of presentation as well as theoretical and methodological issues
- April 20-24 **Multiple Meetings:** Dress rehearsal presentations [all scholars must perform a final version of their presentation in a simulated conference environment (15 minutes with 2 minutes of questions)]  
These presentations should be finely tuned and should incorporate staff comments and suggestions from preliminary round
- April 27-30 Make final revisions to presentations, if necessary
- May 1-2  
(Friday/Saturday) EIP/McNair/GO-MAP Research Conference Oral presentations at the HUB**
- May 15 (Friday) Undergraduate Research Symposium (all OMA-Boeing and Presidential Scholars are required to present either an oral or poster presentation)**
