

English at the University of Washington

Bachelor of Arts in English (*effective Autumn 2005*)

To receive a BA in English, students must complete a minimum of 55 credits (*30 of which must be taken at the 300 to 400 level*), as follows:

ENGL 202 and writing link ENGL 197 10 credits

It is recommended that these courses be completed by the first quarter of admission to the major and no later than the second quarter after admission. ENGL 202/197 may also satisfy prerequisites for admission to the major.

ENGL 302: Critical Practice 5 credits

Should be taken before other upper-division ENGL course work.

English Core 25 credits

At least 5 credits from each of the following categories:*

1. Theories and Methodologies of Language and Literature
2. Forms and Genres of Language and Literature
3. Histories of Language and Literature

(A maximum of 10 credits of 200-level courses may be applied towards the core.)

English Electives (must be 200-level or above) 10 credits

SENIOR Capstone Course 5 credits

Should be taken in the senior year, after 302 and completion of upper-division coursework in the major.

Chosen from ENGL 407, ENGL 430, ENGL 431, ENGL 440, ENGL 442, ENGL 443, ENGL 444, ENGL 451, ENGL 452, ENGL 473, or ENGL 498.

55 credits

A maximum of 20 credits of 200-level courses (including 202) and a maximum of 5 credits of creative writing may be applied towards the major.

At least 15 credits must be in courses focused on pre-1900 literature.

A minimum of 25 credits of English at the 200 level or above must be completed in residence at the University of Washington.

A minimum of 90 credits of the 180 required for graduation must be completed outside the major.

The Department also strongly recommends, but does not require, 5 credits in one of the following English language courses: ENGL 370, ENGL 371, ENGL 373, ENGL 384, ENGL 478, ENGL 479, or LING 200.

Bachelor of Arts in English: *Creative Writing Pathway*

To receive a BA in English following the Creative Writing option, students must complete a minimum of 60 credits (*35 of which must be 300 level and above*) as follows:

ENGL 202 and writing link ENGL 197	10 credits
ENGL 283 and ENGL 284	10 credits
English Core	20 credits
<i>At least 5 credits from each of the following categories*:</i>	
1. Theories and Methodologies of Language and Literature**	
2. Histories of Language and Literature	
ENGL 383 and ENGL 384	10 credits
Approved 400-level Creative Writing Courses	10 credits

	60 credits

A maximum of 20 credits of 200-level courses may be applied towards the major. This includes ENGL 202, 283, and 284.

At least 15 credits must be in courses focused on pre-1900 literature.

A minimum of 25 credits of English at the 200 level or above must be completed in residence at the University of Washington.

A minimum of 90 credits of the 180 required for graduation must be completed outside the major.
