Young Investigator Prize

\$4,800 in 2016

Do you want the opportunity to be a research assistant in a world-class, marine science laboratory with a team of scientists and receive \$4,800 for doing it?

If so, here's what you need to know and do:

The **UW / FHL Young Investigator Prize** is awarded every year to a motivated high school junior showing exceptional promise in the fields of Science and Mathematics.



Interested regional students need to submit a resume, high school transcripts, two letters of recommendation (from teachers or scientists the applicant has previously worked with), and an essay describing their background, why they are seeking the prize, what they will bring to the internship and their career goals. The winner is selected by a committee of University of Washington professors and is awarded a paid internship at FHL (\$4,800 in 2016). ***The winner will spend the summer (8 weeks) as a full time research assistant in a UW / FHL Marine Science Laboratory.***

Application Requirements:

- Student is presently a junior high school student
- Resume
- High School Transcripts
- Two Letters of Recommendation (from teachers or scientists the applicant has previously worked with)
- One - two page essay describing their background, why they are seeking the prize, what they will bring to the internship and their career goals.
