# Young Investigator Prize

**\$3000 in 2011**

*Do you want the opportunity to be a research assistant in a world-class, marine science laboratory with a team of scientists and receive \$3000 for doing it?*

*If so, here's what you need to know and do:*

The **UW / FHL Young Investigator Prize** is awarded every year to a motivated high school junior or senior showing exceptional promise in the fields of Science and Mathematics.

Interested regional students need to submit high school transcripts, two letters of recommendation (from teachers or scientists the applicant has previously worked with), and an essay describing their background and career goals. The winner is selected by a committee of University of Washington professors and is awarded a paid internship at FHL (\$3000 in 2011). *The winner will spend the summer (8 weeks) as a full time research assistant in a UW / FHL Marine Science Laboratory.*



## Application Requirements:

- Student is presently a junior or senior high school student
- High School Transcripts
- Two Letters of Recommendation (from teachers or scientists the applicant has previously worked with)
- Short essay describing the student's background and career goals (one page maximum)
- Contact information: email address, mailing address, and a contact phone number
