# Young Investigator Prize

2010 prize amount to be announced

*Do you want the opportunity to be a research assistant in a world-class, marine ecology laboratory with a team of scientists and be awarded \$\$\$\$ (TBA) for doing it?*

*If so, here's what you need to know and do:*

The **UW / FHL Young Investigator Prize** is awarded every year to a motivated high school junior or senior showing exceptional promise in the fields of Science and Mathematics.



Interested regional students need to submit high school transcripts, two letters of recommendation (from teachers or scientists the applicant has previously worked with), and an essay describing their background and career goals. The winner is selected by a committee of three University of Washington professors and is awarded a cash prize (\$4000 in 2009). *The winner will spend the summer (10 weeks) as a full time research assistant in a UW / FHL Marine Ecology Laboratory.*

## Application Requirements:

- Student is a junior or senior high school student
- High School Transcripts
- Two Letters of Recommendation (from teachers or scientists the applicant has previously worked with)
- Short essay describing the student's background and career goals (one page maximum)
- Contact information: email address and contact phone number
