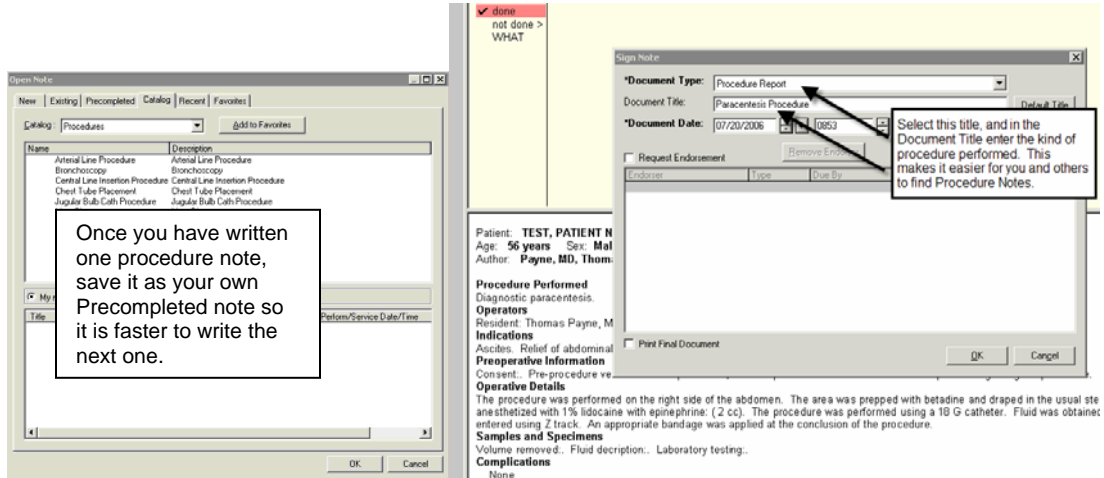


How Many Procedures Have You Done? Find out using VALID. Here's how.

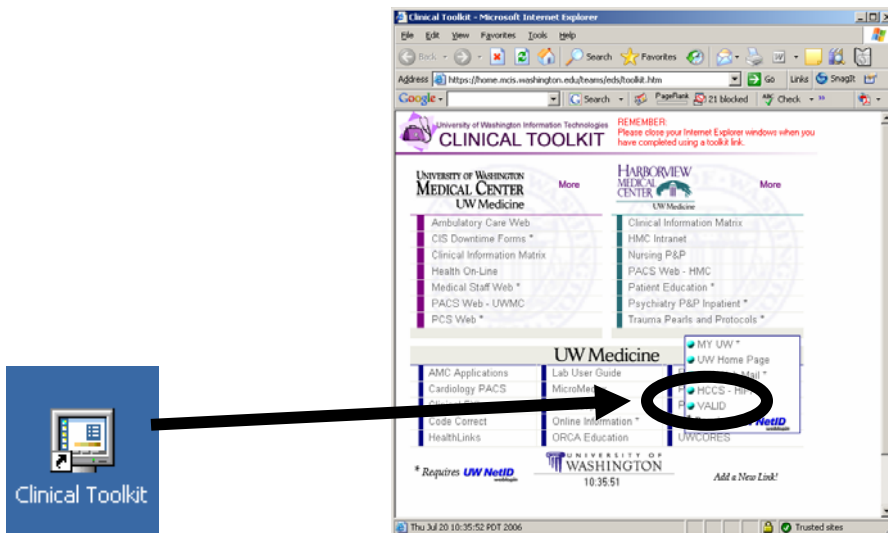
First, write your notes using Powernote templates. Fastest way.

1. Use Powernote templates to write notes for common procedures
2. Save your completed note as a Procedure Report so that you and others can find it quickly.

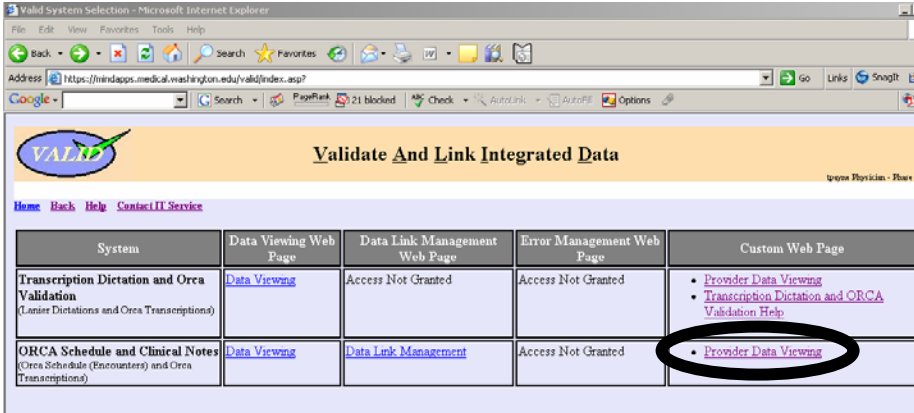


How many procedures have you done since beginning of the year?

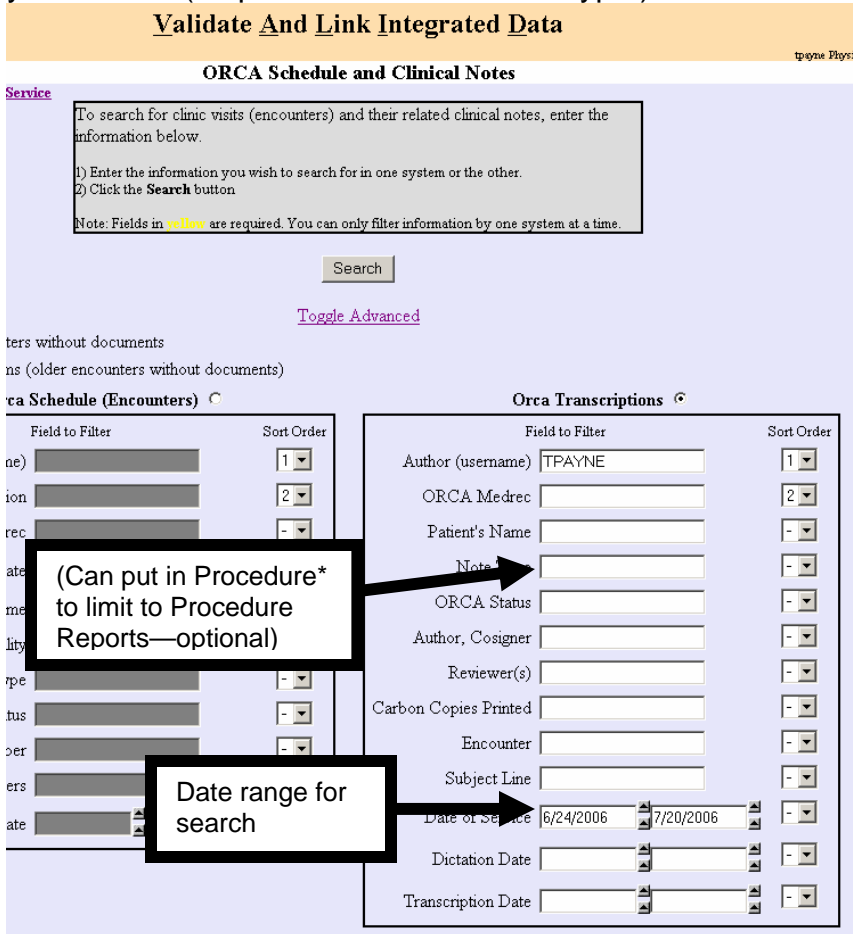
1. Open VALID. You will find it in the Clinical Toolkit icon, under UW Medicine, More. (or using <https://mindapps.medical.washington.edu/valid/index.asp>)



2. In VALID, select Provider Data Viewing



3. Click on Toggle Advanced, and put the date range then click Search to see all your notes. (Or put Procedure* in Note type.) Then click Search



4. All notes you have written in that date range now appear on the screen. Find Procedure Notes, and look in Subject field to see specifics.
