I. PURPOSE OF GREEK WEEK

A. *GREEK WEEK IS A TIME TO CELEBRATE AND ADVANCE THE POTENTIAL OF THE GREEK COMMUNITY*

- I. THIS WEEK GIVES ALL OF THE GREEK CHAPTERS THE OPPORTUNITY TO COME TOGETHER TO FURTHER PHILANTHROPIC AND COMMUNITY RELATED INTERESTS WHILE HAVING FUN.
- II. THE BENEFICIARIES OF OUR PHILANTHROPIES DURING GREEK WEEK 2008 INCLUDE THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY, PUGET SOUND BLOOD CENTER, CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL IN HONOR OF CHASE ANDERSON, THE MOYER FOUNDATION CAMP ERIN, AND ROOTS

II. ALCOHOL

A. *NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 21 SOULD BE CONSUMING ALCOHOL.*

B. *ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED FROM ALL SHEDULED GREEK WEEK EVENTS.*

- I. ATTENDEES AT ANY CHAPTER EVENT WHO ARE NOTICEABLY INTOXICATED, UNRULY, AND DISRUPTIVE WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE VICINITY BY MEMBERS OF THE Panhellenic Association, INTERFRATERNITY COUNCIL, THE GREEK WEEK COMMITTEE AND THE HOST CHAPTER, IF APPLICABLE. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN AN INFRACTION AGAINST THE MEMBER'S CHAPTER.
- II. SHOULD A CHAPTER RECEIVE MORE THAN 4 INTRACIONS, THEY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND WILL NO LONGER BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN FURTHER GREEK WEEK EVENTS. CHAPTERS WILL BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY SHOULD A MEMBER RECEIVE AN INFRACTION.
- III. ADDITIONALLY, WE WILL BE INFORMING THE FACULTY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON WHEN GREEK WEEK IS OCCURRING. WE ASK THAT CHAPTER MEMBERS NOT ATTEND CLASS INTOXICATED. IF A FACULTY MEMBER ASKS A CHAPTER MEMBER WHO THEY FEEL IS NOTICEABLY INTOXICATED, UNRULY, AND DISRUPTIVE TO LEAVE, AND REPORTS THESE INCIDENTS TO THE INDIVIDUALS LISTED ABOVE, A POSSIBLE INFRACTION MAY RESULT AFTER THE MATTER IS FURTHER INVESTIGATED.

III. LIABILITY

A. SPONSORSHIP

- I. ANY AND EVERY CHAPTER THAT HOSTS/SPONSORS AN EVENT, WHETHER IT IS AT THEIR CHAPTER HOUSE OR NOT, CAN BE HELD LIABLE FOR ALL ACTIONS/DAMAGES THAT OCCUR AT THE EVENT BECAUSE THE CHAPTER IS ASSOCIATED WITH THE EVENT.
 1. THIS INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO UNDERAGE DRINKING AND ACCIDENTS AND INJURIES.

B. ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

- I. ALCOHOL THAT IS CONSUMED AND OR DISTRIBUTED AT PLACES NOT AFFILIATED WITH GREEK WEEK STILL POTENTIALLY PLACES LIABILITY ON THE PARTICIPANTS AND THE ORGANIZATIONS THEY BELONG TO.
- II. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH INDIVIDUAL CHAPTER TO EDUCATE THEIR MEMBERS OF THEIR ORGANIZATION'S POLICY REGARDING ALCOHOL, SPONSORSHIP AND THE POLICIES THAT THE GREEK WEEK CHAIRS AND COMMITTEE HAVE PUT IN PLACE TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND UPHOLD THE IMAGE OF THE GREEK COMMUNITY.

IV. SOCIAL EVENTS

A. SPONSORSHIP

- I. ANY FRATERNITY OR SORORITY CHOOSING TO HOST A SOCIAL EVENT DURING THE WEEK OF MAY 5TH THROUGH THE 10TH MUST ABIDE BY ALL POLICIES LISTED WITHIN RECOGNITION AGREEMENT. YOU MUST:
 1. OBTAIN A BANQUET PERMIT
 2. REGISTER FOR THE EVENT AT LEAST 7 DAYS PRIOR WITH THE OFFICE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS, WITH SIGNATURES FROM APPROPRIATE PARTIES.
 3. REGULATE ACCESS TO THE FACILITY HOSTING THE EVENT AND ACCESS TO ANY AND ALL ALCOHOL CONSUMED DURING THE EVENT.
