The Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) conducts program reviews of academic departments that coincide with the Graduate School's Program Review process. GPSS reviews are a vital component of the final Graduate School Program Report. The data collected and presented by the GPSS serve as a primary source of graduate and/or professional student feedback in the Graduate School's Program Review process.

The first part is based on an electronically administered Catalyst survey requesting feedback from the graduate and/or professional students within the academic unit being reviewed. The survey results are largely quantitative.

Review, Scope, and Purpose

This review *does* contain a summary of graduate student opinions regarding their experiences in the School. This review *does not* seek to evaluate the School or give a general overview of the academic programs.

Summary of Findings

The Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) sponsored and administered a Catalyst survey to the graduate and/or professional students in the University of Washington's Department of Materials Science and Engineering on December 9th, 2015. The purpose of this survey was to ensure the voices and opinions of the students within the Master's and doctoral programs are included in the review process and thereby taken into account during the planning of the future direction of the School's programs.

We collected responses from ten students within the department. Nine of the ten students are enrolled full time. Please keep these numbers in mind when looking at the data in the following reports. Our student's response group encompassed four Master's students (40.00%), five Doctoral students (50.00%) and one student who did not specify. Of the respondents, one student (10.00%) was international.

Data Results

Following this review, you will find a complete list of questions, responses and response statistics for your reference. The survey attempted to be comprehensive by asking a wide range of questions. Responses to "Do you have any additional comments you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?" are also listed.

Data Findings

Obstacle Areas

When looking at obstacle areas, it seems as though respondents were split in their opinion that the Department of Materials Sciences and Engineering helps students address challenges. In terms of the availability of faculty and staff, 1 student (10.00%) stated it was a major obstacle, 2 students (20.00%) stated it was somewhat of an obstacle, 2 students (20.00%) stated it was a minor obstacle, 4 students (40.00%) stated it was not an obstacle and 1 student (10.00%) stated it was not applicable. In terms of the program structure, 6 students (60.00%) stated it was a minor obstacle, 3 students (30.00%) stated it was not an obstacle and 1 student (10.00%) stated it was not applicable. To see the full break down of obstacles including work/financial commitments, research facilities/space/technology and family obligations, please see the raw data attached.

Departmental Feedback

When asked if respondents received feedback from the program/department advisors, 1 student (11.11%) responded yes, and 8 students (88.89%) responded no while 1 student did not answer. Conversely, when asked if they would like feedback from their program/department advisors, 8 students (88.89%) stated

they would want some degree of feedback, 1 student (11.11%) stated they would not like feedback, and 1 student did not answer.

Departmental Funding

When asked if respondents felt their program provided enough funding for their students, 5 students (50.00%) stated yes, 3 students (30.00%0 stated no, while 2 students (20.00%) stated that they were unsure. When asked about size of loans accrued by the completion of the degree, 6 students (66.67%) stated they would leave with 0\$ in loans, one student did not respond and the remaining three students were varied in loan size from \$1-\$9,999 and \$25,000-\$39,999.

Free Response Questions

Q: Are there any additional comments regarding *funding issues* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. It is absurd there is no funding (ta, ra opportunities) for applied masters students. I might not have loans when I'm done but I will have no savings and be close to broke if I don't land a job immediately.

2. I feel as though the associated health insurance is unclear.

3. It is quite unfortunate that Masters students cannot get a TA position. I also do not get paid for research, which I do 30 hours a week so cannot get a job! Just had to take out a massive loan instead.

4. I have my schooling paid for through my current place of employment so am not terribly familiar with funding.

Q. Are there any additional comments regarding *career counseling and employment assistance* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. Great Job!

Q. Are there any additional comments regarding your *research experience* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. I am in my first quarter of this program so I do not have much exposure yet.

Q. Are there any additional comments regarding your *academic program* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. Professors do not seem invested in classes – some do not even hold office hours.
