The Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) conducts program reviews of academic departments that coincide with the Graduate School's Program Review process. GPSS reviews are a vital component of the final Graduate School Program Report. The data collected and presented by the GPSS serve as a primary source of graduate and/or professional student feedback in the Graduate School's Program Review process.

The first part is based on an electronically administered Catalyst survey requesting feedback from the graduate and/or professional students within the academic unit being reviewed. The survey results are largely quantitative.

Review, Scope, and Purpose

This review *does* contain a summary of graduate student opinions regarding their experiences in the School. This review *does not* seek to evaluate the School or give a general overview of the academic programs.

Summary of Findings

The Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) sponsored and administered a Catalyst survey to the graduate and/or professional students in the University of Washington's Department of Oral Health Sciences on November 4th, 2015. The purpose of this survey was to ensure the voices and opinions of the students within the Master's and doctoral programs are included in the review process and thereby taken into account during the planning of the future direction of the School's programs.

The department is comprised of 20 students both Master's and Doctoral students/candidates. We collected responses from six of these students. Each of the six students was enrolled full time. Please keep these numbers in mind when looking at the data in the following reports. Our student's response group encompassed one Master's student (16.67%), two Doctoral students (33.33%) and three Doctoral candidates (50.00%). Of the respondents, 50.00% were international.

Data Results

Following this review, you will find a complete list of questions, responses and response statistics for your reference. The survey attempted to be comprehensive by asking a wide range of questions. Responses to "Do you have any additional comments you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?" are also listed.

Data Findings

Obstacle Areas

When looking at obstacle areas, it seems as though most respondents feel that the Department of Oral Health Sciences helps students address challenges. In terms of providing research facilities/space/technology, 100% of respondents said it was not an obstacle. Availability of faculty was split 50/50 between respondents saying it was not an obstacle or it was a minor obstacle. Program structure was 83.33% not an obstacle for respondents and somewhat of an obstacle for 16.66% (one student) of respondents. Finally, in terms of course scheduling, 66.66% of students said it was not an obstacle while the remaining 33.33% said it was a minor obstacle. Most of the responses were comprised of mainly "not an obstacle" response choices.

Departmental Feedback

When asked if respondents received feedback from the program/department advisors, 100% of respondents stated they did not receive any feedback and 100% of respondents also stated they wished they had received some feedback.

Departmental Funding

When asked if respondents felt their program provided enough funding for their students, 33.33% of students responded yes, 50.00% responded no, and 16.66%, one student, responded yes. We also asked about size of loans incurred from the program and 50.00% said they had \$0 in loans, while the other respondents ranged from \$10,000-\$54,999 in loans.

Free Response Questions

Q: Are there any additional comments regarding *funding issues* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. There are a shortage of mentors with funding who can support both a student and the work that they will perform (i.e. lab equipment and associated research costs)

2. I think our program does not have enough funding to support students. Some students have to pay out of their pocket for tuition. Many students including me have scholarships from their own countries.

Q. Are there any additional comments regarding *career counseling and employment assistance* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. I don't think our program has career counseling. It would be nice if we have one.

Q. Are there any additional comments regarding your *research experience* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. Faculty here are outstanding.

Q. Are there any additional comments regarding your *academic program* that you would like GPSS to know and/or include in the report?

1. My concern regarding our current situation of the program is that there are very few labs that have funding in dental school. Thus, students have to find labs in other departments. As a result, students don't have guidance to relate their work to dental field. Moreover, some students have hard time finding lab to stay.
