Course Description:

Green & Krueter's PRECEDE/PROCEED model for health program planning and evaluation is employed as a conceptual framework in this **three credit two-quarter course**. Five assignments are required: (1) the description of selected program, (2) a delineation or logic model, (3) a budget, and (4) a Gantt chart. The fifth and final assignment is 10-15 double-spaced type-written protocol based on a real-world health program chosen by the student.

Assignments:

All assignments are to be typed and double-spaced in 12 point font. Include your name. Assignment I is due at the February seminar meeting. Assignments II - IV are due at the April seminar meeting. Assignment V is due the last day of instruction in the Spring quarter.
