

Biography: Hazel Taylor

Dr. Hazel Taylor is an Assistant Professor at the Information School, University of Washington, Seattle. She holds a Ph.D. from Queensland University of Technology, Brisbane, Australia. Prior to joining the Information School, Dr. Taylor taught at the University of Waikato in New Zealand, and at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, and conducted research in Hong Kong on risk management and tacit knowledge in IT projects. Her teaching and research focuses on IT project management and risk management with an emphasis on tacit knowledge and decision making in these areas. Dr. Taylor has published a number of articles and book chapters on aspects of project management, risk management, outsourced projects, tacit knowledge and decision making. Prior to her academic career, Hazel worked in industry with manufacturing, construction and government organizations, both as a systems manager and an IT project manager.
