The Huskies Dance Team practices year round to prepare for upcoming performances and competitions. There are several different national organizations that hold collegiate dance competitions. The Universal Dance Association (UDA), the National Dance Association (NDA) and United Spirit Association (USA) hold regional competitions each summer. These competitions qualify dance teams for nationals which are held every January in Florida.

CLUB DUES

CLUB DISCLAIMER

Any competitive/non-competitive dancer may join the club even though this is a competitive team sport, although this is not a dance class. The club consists of two divisions: the 'A' team and Tuesday open practice. The 'A' team dancers will be in the group that performs the piece that is currently being learned. If a dancer is not selected to be on the 'A' team, they may participate in the Tuesday open practices to learn the dance routines.

All currently enrolled UW students (Seattle campus) and faculty/staff IMA members may join the club. Faculty/staff may purchase their IMA Membership at the IMA Member Services Desk during operation hours.

UW extension, branch campus students, students of the ASUW experimental college, UW alumni, and the general public are not eligible to participate in the club sports program.
