

# BASKETBALL LEAGUES

## ACTIVITY

Leagues are offered for men's, women's, and co-rec teams. Individuals or teams may sign-up for five weeks of round robin league play. All teams without a forfeit will advance to a single elimination playoff tournament. The seeding into the playoffs will be determined by league standings with divisions tiered by win-loss records. Modified High School Federation Basketball rules will govern play. A co-rec team consists of 2 men and 3 women on the court.

**Note Shirt Rule:** Teams will be designated as home (light colored shirt) and away (dark colored shirt) as indicated on the schedules. Teams are responsible for wearing the appropriate colored shirt each game. Team captain's need to check the schedules carefully.

## ENTRY PROCEDURES

Team captains must submit their completed team roster and entry fee prior to the deadline in the Programs Office, 3rd floor IMA. Changes to the roster must be made on the last Wednesday of the regular season prior to the start of playoffs.

**Entries will be taken on a first come first serve basis.** Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm, beginning December 12. Rosters are limited to 10 players per team. Entries will be accepted after this date if space is available. We will be using [IMleagues.com](http://IMleagues.com) to manage the league.

## FREE AGENTS MEETING

Thursday, January 5, at 4:00PM, Lounge, IMA Building. Team captains are asked to take the on-line test at [IMleagues.com](http://IMleagues.com) covering program policies and league rules. No need to attend the meeting unless you wish to do so.

## ELIGIBILITY

All 2012 Winter Quarter UW students, faculty and staff members are eligible. Faculty/Staff members must purchase an annual or quarterly IMA Membership. Former or current intercollegiate basketball team members should refer to the *Intramural Sports Handbook* for eligibility requirements. **Participants are limited to playing on only one men's team and one co-rec team.**

## PLAYING DAYS & TIMES

Available league times are listed on the back of this flyer. Teams select the day and time they want to play during the regular season. For playoffs teams need to be available to play on any day at any time as scheduled.

## COMPETITIVE DIVISIONS

### Rainier Division:

This is a recreational division. It offers a less competitive environment for teams that desire to participate in a more relaxed atmosphere. Competition is open to undergraduate students only.

### Olympic Division:

This is a recreational division. Competition is open to graduate students and faculty/staff members only. Undergraduate students may participate in this division with permission from the Program Coordinator.

### Cascade Division:

This division is offered for teams seeking a high level of competition. Faculty/Staff and graduate students may participate in this division if it fits their skill level.

### Co-Rec & Women's Open Division:

During the regular season, there will be no separate divisions based on skill level or experience. Teams will be placed into Cascade or Rainier Divisions for the playoffs based on regular season records.

Note: The Intramural Sports Staff reserve the right to place teams in the appropriate level of competition if it is deemed necessary to do so.

Team captains are encouraged to send a person to be trained as an official. The officials' orientation meeting is on Tuesday, January 3, at 4:00pm, in the IMA Meeting Room. For further information contact the Programs Office at 543-8558.
