

SOFTBALL LEAGUES

ACTIVITY

Competition consists of teams playing a five-week round robin schedule with leagues for men's and co-rec teams. All teams without a forfeit will advance to a single elimination playoff. The seeding into the playoffs will be determined by league standings with the divisions tiered by win-loss records. A co-rec team consists of five males and five females with batting order alternating male/female. Official ASA slow-pitch softball rules with intramural modifications will govern play.

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURES

Teams or individuals may enter this activity by submitting their team roster and team entry fee of **\$40.00** to the Programs Office by the entry deadline date. Entries will be accepted from 9:00am – 6:00pm, Monday through Friday, beginning June 9. First come, first serve. Sign up early.

TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

Thursday, June 26, 5:15pm, IMA Meeting Room. The meeting agenda will include the following topics: player eligibility, schedule information, protest procedures, rules, and other important information that team captains are responsible for knowing. The meeting is expected to last 20-30 minutes.

ELIGIBILITY

All 2008 Summer Quarter UW students, faculty, staff and Spring Quarter students with a Summer IMA membership are eligible. In addition to the team fee, faculty, staff and Spring Quarter students must purchase a quarterly faculty & staff or student (\$48) IMA Membership to participate. Players may participate on only one men's team and one co-rec team. See the *Intramural Sports Handbook* for further details.

One competitive division will be offered for all leagues during the regular season. Teams may be placed in Rainier (recreational) or Cascade (competitive) divisions for the playoffs based on league standings.
