

TENNIS TOURNAMENT

EVENT

The men's and women's singles tennis tournament is double elimination. Classes A, B, & C will be offered.

ENTRIES DUE

Wednesday, July 2, at 5:00pm in the Programs Office.

ENTRY FEE AND PROCEDURES

Individuals may enter this activity by submitting your entry form and entry fee of **\$10.00** to the Programs Office by the entry deadline date. Entries will be accepted from 9:00am-6:00pm, Monday through Friday, beginning June 9.

DATE

The tournament starts on Thursday, July 3. The draw will be posted July 3, at the Programs Office, IMA Building.

ELIGIBILITY

All 2008 Summer Quarter UW students, faculty, staff and Spring Quarter students with a Summer IMA Membership are eligible. In addition to the entry fee, faculty, staff and Spring Quarter students must purchase a quarterly faculty & staff or student (\$48) IMA Membership to participate. Check the *Intramural Sports Handbook* for additional eligibility requirements.

REFUNDS

No refunds after the draw has been posted on July 3.



TOURNAMENT FORMAT

After the entry due date passes, individuals are placed in brackets on a random basis. The draw will be posted in the IMA Building and copies are made available for participants. It is your responsibility to contact your opponent and play the match before the established score reporting deadline.

You are responsible for reserving your own court and the court reservation card must be picked up at the Member Services Desk prior to each match. For court reservations call 543-6971 between 8am-4:30pm, M-F (Same day reservations: only until 11am.)

The winner of each match must report the score to the Programs Office or Program Coordinator prior to the due date on the schedule. Each player should then find out who his/her next opponent is and contact them to play the next match.

SCHEDULING SKILL LEVELS

If any particular division is lacking in numbers, enough for a proper tournament, we will contact each person and inquire about refunding the fee or moving up to the next skill level.

FOUL WEATHER POLICY

If you are faced with a light rain, most players will continue. If play is not possible on the agreed upon day/time, the score reporting deadline will be extended, if necessary, until better conditions exist.

FORFEITURES

Please call in your intent to forfeit at 206-543-8558. Looking for your opponent? The best bet is to go to the court and wait. Don't be quick to assume a forfeit! Your opponent might have done the same thing.
