

VOLLEYBALL LEAGUES

ACTIVITY

The leagues for co-rec teams are 6 a side (3 men, 3 women) playing a five-week round robin schedule. All teams without a forfeit will advance to a single elimination tournament. The seeding into the playoffs will be determined by league standings with the divisions tiered by win-loss records. State High School Association rules will govern play except for the intramural program modifications as noted in the rules.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Individuals or teams may enter this activity by submitting their name or team roster to the Programs Office, 3rd floor IMA, beginning September 21. Entries will be taken Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm.

TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

Thursday, October 8, at 4:30pm, Lounge, IMA Building. The meeting agenda will include the following topics: player eligibility, schedule information, protest procedures, rules review, and other important information that team captains are responsible for knowing. The meeting is expected to last 30-45 minutes.

ELIGIBILITY

All 2009 Autumn Quarter UW students, faculty and staff IMA members are eligible. Faculty/Staff members must purchase an annual or quarterly IMA Membership. Current intercollegiate volleyball players are not eligible. Former intercollegiate players are eligible with some restrictions. UW Volleyball Club players must play in the highest skill division offered when eligible, and are limited to no more than two per team roster. Check the *Intramural Sports Handbook* for additional eligibility requirements.

FREE AGENTS

The free agent program assists in helping individuals to become participants on teams even if they don't know enough people on campus to form a team. All it takes is signing up on a free agent roster in the Programs Office and attending the captains' meeting.

PLAYING DAYS AND TIMES

Available playing times are listed on the back of this bulletin. Choice of days and times will be on a first come first served basis. Games begin the week of October 12. We will utilize IMleagues.com to manage the league.

COMPETITIVE DIVISIONS

Rainier Division:

Beginners who have played little or no volleyball and have not played organized volleyball other than intramurals. For those interested in playing for fun and improving their skills.

Olympic Division:

This is a recreational division for the person who is not overly competitive or who has not been involved extensively in competition before. This division is open to graduate students and faculty/staff IMA members only. Undergraduates are permitted to participate in this division with permission from the Intramural Coordinator.

Cascade Division:

This division is for those who have played volleyball at least one year competitively, have played intramurals before, or have been successful in other leagues. Teams will be limited to two UW club team members. Players who compete or have competed at the "A" or "B" club levels must play in this division.

AWARDS

Each member of the championship team for each division will receive an Intramural Championship T-shirt.
