## TYPE OF TOURNAMENT

## ELIGIBILITY

All 2012 Winter Quarter UW students, faculty and staff members are eligible. Faculty/Staff members must purchase an annual or quarterly IMA Membership. See the *Intramural Sports Handbook* for more information.

## CHOOSING THE PROPER DIVISION

Teams should play at the level of the best player; for example, an "A" player paired with a "B" player must play in the Cascade Division. Club and USVBA players must play in the Cascade Division.

## PLAYING DAYS AND TIMES

Times allotted for playing are Mondays (4:00pm – 7:40pm) and Tuesdays (4:00pm – 7:40pm). Teams must be available to play at anytime. We will utilize [IMleagues.com](http://IMleagues.com) to manage the tournament.

## COMPETITIVE DIVISIONS

### Rainier:

This is a recreational division. Only open to beginning or novice players, those who play in our regular Rainier volleyball leagues.

### Cascade:

This is a competitive division for those who know the game and play in our regular Cascade volleyball leagues. All club, high skill level players, and USVBA participants must play in this division and **only one high skill level player is allowed per team.**

### Olympic:

This is a recreational division open to graduate students and faculty/staff members only.

## REPORTING OF MATCH RESULTS

The winner must report match results to the Tournament Coordinator immediately following the match. Failure to do so will result in double forfeiture of the match. Being ready to play is the key to this tournament. Please check the schedule carefully to ensure you know when your next match is.
