

Materials for your Partner Child

Create a Name Book for your Partner Child

Materials needed: Construction paper, pictures from magazines, clip art or the Internet, markers, stapler.

1. Fold multiple sheets of construction paper in half and staple to form a book.
2. Decorate the cover of the book with a picture of your child or a picture of something that your child likes.
3. Use each letter of the child's name for each page and attach a corresponding picture.
4. For example, if your child's name is Sarah, on the first page you would write an S. On the next page, you would put a picture of something that starts with an S, such as a sun, sailboat or sneaker.
5. Share the book with your child during one-to-one reading. If your child wants to, you could make another book during Choice Time with new pictures or add pictures onto the book that you made.

Other Book Ideas

- Recipe Books – Use serious recipes (like sugar cookies) or funny ones (like dinosaur soup)
- Song Books – Write down lyrics to favorite children songs that they can take home to sing with their family
- All About Me Books – Create your own children's book starring your partner child! Great for children who do not like reading 1-1.
