The following are excellent resources for to enhance the classroom!

Sign-In

Sign-In is an important part of the Jumpstart session. There are many options for having a creative sign-in.

- **Sign-In Tree**
 - Create a large tree out of poster board, cardboard, or butcher paper. Make sure to have lots of branches but no leaves. You can print out leaves and have the children sign their name on the leaves and then place them on the tree! You can also laminate the leaves to be reused.
- **Sign-In Mailbox**
 - Another popular idea. Decorate a small shoebox to look like a real mailbox and leave a small space in the top for children to “mail” their name. You can then take out sign-ins during circle to do attendance!
- **Sign-In Chart**
 - Like the picture below, create a sign-in chart with a space for each child’s name. Using sticks and pouches, or Velcro, have children place the sticks in their space to note attendance. To increase writing, laminate the materials so children can write their name each day.
- **Other Ideas**
 - Sign-In Ocean (with fish for children to sign their name on)
 - Sign-In Barnyard (with different animals)
 - Sign-In Name Tags (so children can wear their name all day – useful for the beginning of the quarter)
 - Sign-In Puppets
