Update on UW-Kenya employees Currently, UW-Kenya has 79 employees. There are 52 full time employees, 24 part time employees and 2 consultants. UW-Kenya employees work in Nairobi, Mombasa, Kakamega, Kisumu, Kisii, Homa Bay, and Migori.

Featured study - DASH (Developing Adolescent Strategies for HIV Testing) - is an exciting new collaborative study led by Drs. Pamela Kohler, Jennifer Slyker, Dalton Wamalwa, and David Bukusi at the University of Washington, University of Nairobi, and the Kenyatta National Hospital Youth Voluntary Counseling and Testing (VCT) Clinic. This study will use classic implementation science methods -- flow mapping, time in motion, continuous quality improvement -- to empower and assist existing VCT health care workers to take their own innovative ideas about how to improve the adolescent HIV testing experience and test them using scientific methods. Additionally, focus group discussions and in-depth interviews will explore experiences of HIV-testing among adolescents, their caregivers, and health care providers.
