GENERAL COMMITTEE UNANIMOUSLY TURNS DOWN PROPOSE

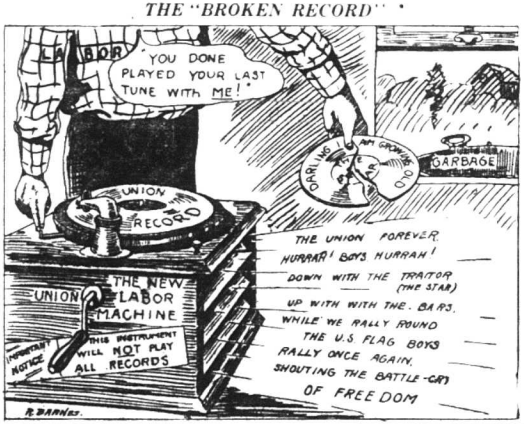
