Volunteers needed for neuroimaging research study

Experiments investigating brain areas involved in attending to sound sources

We are looking for volunteers to participate in a behavioral and brain imaging study. You should be at least 13 years old and not have any known hearing loss. You should have normal/corrected vision and be willing to loosen your hair for M/EEG (magneto-/electro-encephalography) experiments if you have braided or tightly pulled back hair. You should not have metallic parts in your body, or any other factor to exclude you from M/EEG or MRI (magnetic resonance imaging) experiments.

Depending on the experiment, you may participate in cognitive and audiological assessment, behavioral, M/EEG, and/or MRI sessions. Experimental sessions would take place on separate days. You may be asked to perform auditory and/or visual tasks. Sessions last approximately 1 to 3 hours (number of sessions varies).
